Dunorys Inc. Privacy Policy



The Dunorys Privacy Policy was updated on March 19, 2017.

Your privacy is important to Dunorys. So, we've developed a Privacy Policy that covers how we collect, use, disclose, transfer, and store your information. Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with our privacy practices and let us know if you have any questions.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

Personal information is data that can be used to identify or contact a single person.

You may be asked to provide your personal information anytime you are in contact withDunorys or a Dunorys affiliated company. Dunorys and its affiliates may share this personal information with each other and use it consistent with this Privacy Policy. They may also combine it with other information to provide and improve our products, services, content, and advertising. You are not required to provide the personal information that we have requested, but, if you chose not to do so, in many cases we will not be able to provide you with our products or services or respond to any queries you may have.

Here are some examples of the types of personal information Dunorys may collect and how we may use it:

What personal information we collect

- When you create an Dunorys ID, apply for commercial credit, purchase a product, download a software update, contact us or participate in an online survey, we may collect a variety of information, including your name, mailing address, phone number, email address, contact preferences, and credit card information.
- When you share your content with family and friends using Dunorys products, send gift certificates and products, or invite others to participate in Dunorys services or forums, Dunorys may collect the information you provide about those people such as name, mailing address, email address, and phone number. Dunorys will use such information to fulfil your requests, provide the relevant product or service, or for anti-fraud purposes.
- In certain jurisdictions, we may ask for a government issued ID in limited circumstances including when setting up a wireless account, for the purpose of extending commercial credit, managing reservations, or as required by law.

How we use your personal information

- The personal information we collect allows us to keep you posted on Dunorys's latest product announcements, software updates, and upcoming events. If you don't want to be on our mailing list, you can opt out anytime by updating your preferences.
- We also use personal information to help us create, develop, operate, deliver, and improve our products, services, content and advertising, and for loss prevention and anti-fraud purposes.

- We may use your personal information, including date of birth, to verify identity, assist with identification of users, and to determine appropriate services. For example, we may use date of birth to determine the age of Dunorys ID account holders.
- From time to time, we may use your personal information to send important notices, such as communications about purchases and changes to our terms, conditions, and policies. Because this information is important to your interaction with Dunorys, you may not opt out of receiving these communications.
- We may also use personal information for internal purposes such as auditing, data analysis, and research to improve Dunorys's products, services, and customer communications.
- If you enter into a sweepstake, contest, or similar promotion we may use the information you provide to administer those programs.

Collection and Use of Non-Personal Information

We also collect data in a form that does not, on its own, permit direct association with any specific individual. We may collect, use, transfer, and disclose non-personal information for any purpose. The following are some examples of non-personal information that we collect and how we may use it:

- We may collect information such as occupation, language, zip code, area code, unique device identifier, referrer URL, location, and the time zone where an Dunorys product is used so that we can better understand customer behaviour and improve our products, services, and advertising.
- We may collect information regarding customer activities on our website, Creaoz, Dunetos, Shikshaone, Inbric CRM, Atrenos AI and from our other products and services. This information is aggregated and used to help us provide more useful information to our customers and to understand which parts of our website, products, and services are of most interest. Aggregated data is considered non-personal information for the purposes of this Privacy Policy.
- We may collect and store details of how you use our services, including search queries. This information may be used to improve the relevancy of results provided by our services. Except in limited instances to ensure quality of our services over the Internet, such information will not be associated with your IP address.
- With your explicit consent, we may collect data about how you use your device and applications in order to help app developers improve their apps.

If we do combine non-personal information with personal information the combined information will be treated as personal information for as long as it remains combined.

Cookies and Other Technologies

Dunorys's websites, online services, interactive applications, email messages, and advertisements may use "cookies" and other technologies such as pixel tags and web beacons. These technologies help us better understand user behaviour, tell us which parts of our websites people have visited, and facilitate and measure the effectiveness of advertisements and web searches. We treat information collected by cookies and other technologies as non-personal information. However, to the extent that Internet Protocol (IP) addresses or similar identifiers are considered personal information by local law, we also treat these identifiers as personal information. Similarly, to the extent that non-personal information is combined with personal information, we treat the combined information as personal information for the purposes of this Privacy Policy.

Dunorys and our partners also use cookies and other technologies to remember personal information when you use our website, online services, and applications. Our goal in these cases is to make your experience with Dunorys more convenient and personal. For example, knowing your first name lets us welcome you the next time you visit the Dunorys. Knowing your country and language – and if you are an educator, your school – helps us provide a customized and more useful experience. And knowing your contact information, hardware identifiers, and information about your computer or device helps us to provide you with better customer service.

If you want to disable cookies, you can do so but please note that certain features of the Dunorys website will not be available once cookies are disabled.

As is true of most internet services, we gather some information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, browser type and language, Internet service provider (ISP), referring and exit websites and applications, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data.

We use this information to understand and analyse trends, to administer the site, to learn about user behaviour on the site, to improve our product and services, and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. Dunorys may use this information in our marketing and advertising services.

In some of our email messages, we use a "click-through URL" linked to content on the Dunorys website. When customers click one of these URLs, they pass through a separate web server before arriving at the destination page on our website. We track this click-through data to help us determine interest in particular topics and measure the effectiveness of our customer communications. If you prefer not to be tracked in this way, you should not click text or graphic links in the email messages.

Disclosure to Third Parties

At times Dunorys may make certain personal information available to strategic partners that work with Dunorys to provide products and services, or that help Dunorys market to customers. Personal information will only be shared by Dunorys to provide or improve our products, services and advertising; it will not be shared with third parties for their marketing purposes.

Service Providers

Dunorys shares personal information with companies who provide services such as information processing, extending credit, fulfilling customer orders, delivering products to you, managing and enhancing customer data, providing customer service, assessing your interest in our products and services, and conducting customer research or satisfaction surveys. These companies are obligated to protect your information and may be located wherever Dunorys operates.

Others

It may be necessary – by law, legal process, litigation, and/or requests from public and governmental authorities within or outside your country of residence – for Dunorys to disclose your personal information. We may also disclose information about you if we determine that for purposes of national security, law enforcement, or other issues of public importance, disclosure is necessary or appropriate.

We may also disclose information about you if we determine that disclosure is reasonably necessary to enforce our terms and conditions or protect our operations or users. Additionally, in the event of a reorganization, merger, or sale we may transfer any and all personal information we collect to the relevant third party.

Protection of Personal Information

Dunorys takes the security of your personal information very seriously. Dunorys online services such as the Shikshaone and Inbric protect your personal information during transit using encryption such as Transport Layer Security (TLS). When your personal data is stored by Dunorys, we use computer systems with limited access housed in facilities using physical security measures. The data is stored in encrypted form including when we utilize third-party storage.

When you use some Dunorys products, services, or applications or post on an Dunorys forum, chat room, or social networking service, the personal information and content you share is visible to other users and can be read, collected, or used by them. You are responsible for the personal information you choose to share or submit in these instances. For example, if you list your name and email address in a forum posting, that information is public. Please take care when using these features.

Location-Based Services

To provide location-based services on Dunorys products, Dunorys and our partners and licensees may collect, use, and share precise location data, including the real-time geographic location of your computer or device. Where available, location-based services may use GPS, Bluetooth, and your IP Address, along with crowd-sourced Wi-Fi hotspot and cell tower locations, and other technologies to determine your devices' approximate location. Unless you provide consent, this location data is collected anonymously in a form that does not personally identify you and is used by Dunorys and our partners and licensees to provide and improve location-based products and services. For example, your device may share its geographic location with application providers when you opt in to their location services.

Third-Party Sites and Services

Dunorys websites, products, applications, and services may contain links to third-party websites, products, and services. Our products and services may also use or offer products or services from third parties.

Information collected by third parties, which may include such things as location data or contact details, is governed by their privacy practices. We encourage you to learn about the privacy practices of those third parties.

International Users

All the information you provide may be transferred or accessed by entities around the world as described in this Privacy Policy. Dunorys uses approved Model Contractual Clauses for the international transfer of personal information collected in the European Economic Area and Switzerland. Dunorys, as a global company, has a number of legal entities in different jurisdictions which are responsible for the personal information which they collect and which is processed on their behalf by Dunorys Inc. Dunorys, ShikshaOne and Inbric related personal information may also be controlled by legal entities outside the India as reflected in the terms of each service.

Dunorys abides by the <u>Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Cross Border Privacy Rules System</u>. The APEC CBPR system provides a framework for organizations to ensure protection of personal information transferred among participating APEC economies.
